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What Is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will replace the culvert on M-30 over No Name Drain in Gladwin County

Work includes box culvert replacement and approach work for the M-30 culvert, as well as upgrades to a section of the detour route (Shock Road/Hockaday Road) between Badger Road and Highwood Road.

When Will This Be Done?

Upgrades to the detour route will occur prior to the Independence Day holiday. A full detour via M-61, Shock Road/Hockaday Road, and Knox Road will go into effect following the holiday. The project is expected to be completed by October.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

This project will require a full detour. Motorists are advised to use the approved detour route: M-61, Shock Road/Hockaday Road, and Knox Road.

Long-term Benefits

This project will improve the condition and safety of the roadway.
