What Is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will be reconstructing 6.2 miles of M-33 in Cheboygan County, from south of Long Lake Road to M-27. This work will include replacement of a culvert north of M-212.

When Will This Be Done?

Construction is scheduled to begin in February and be completed in September.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

This work will require a detour for through-traffic on M-27, I-75 and M-68. Access for residents and users of Aloha State Park will be maintained, though access will shift between M-27 and M-68 based on project progress.

Long-term Benefits

This project will extend the service life of this section of M-33, and improve safety, convenience and ride quality for motorists. Additionally, this route will be upgraded to all-season standards when complete; the road is currently subject to seasonal weight restrictions.
