

What Is Being Done?

Resurfacing M-82 (Main Street) from Market Avenue east to Stewart Street, along with sidewalk ramp upgrades.

When Will This Be Done?

Work begins in May and is expected to continue until July.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

Traffic will be maintained with single-lane closures and flag control when necessary.

During resurfacing between Weaver Avenue and Stewart Street, the same detour route used during the National Baby Food Festival will be in effect: Weaver Avenue, Elm Street, and Stewart Street.

Long-term Benefits

This project will improve pedestrian access along M-82 and extend the service life of the road.
