Bid documents will only be issued through the Michigan Intergovernmental Trade Network (MITN). Description: The Muskegon Area Transit System (MATS) will undertake a significant renovation and addition to its bus passenger terminal at 351 Morris Ave., Muskegon, MI. The completed facility will be approx. 5,500 s.f. and the project will include approx. 1.3 acres of site work including utilities, pavement and landscaping.

Bid: Project will be bid by General Contractors as a single lump sum. All subcontractors must be clearly identified in the bid documents.

Bond Requirements: Bid, Performance, and Payment bonds are all required.

Contract Conditions: A Pre-Bid Conference will be held in early October 2014, at Muskegon County Training Center Building, 133 E. Apple Ave, Muskegon, MI 49442. Bidders are strongly encouraged to attend. Davis Bacon Prevailing Wage rates will apply.
