



Quicken Loans 400 NASCAR Sprint Cup Series Michigan International Speedway (MIS) Sunday, June 16

- I-96, Livingston County, has one eastbound lane closed at Latson Road until 5 p.m. on Saturday, June 15. Westbound I-96 will have a one lane closed on Saturday between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.
- I-496 in Lansing, Ingham County, has one lane open in each direction between Lansing Road and Clemens Street.
- M-50 in Charlotte, Eaton County, is closed between Cochran Avenue and I-69 with a detour posted. Also, M-50 is closed between Vermontville Highway and Needmore Highway, north of Charlotte, with a detour posted.
- M-50, Jackson County, has all lanes open between Napoleon and Brooklyn during race weekend.
- M-60, Jackson County, has one lane open under flag control between the Calhoun County line and Concord on Friday, June 14. All lanes will be open on Saturday and Sunday of race weekend.
- M-99, Jackson County, is closed just south of Springport with a detour posted.
- US-23, Monroe County, has two lanes open in each direction.
- US-127, Ingham County, has one lane open in each direction between I-69 and Lake Lansing Road.
- US-223 at US-23, Monroe County, has the southbound US-23 off ramp to US-223 and the US-223 on ramp to northbound US-23 closed with a detour posted. In addition, two-way traffic is maintained on the east side of the interchange, between Whiteford Center Road and the northbound US-223 exit ramp, using temporary signals.
