Traffic restrictions:

- US-223, Lenawee County, has one lane of traffic maintained using a temporary traffic signal at two separate locations near Riga Highway and Lipp Highway, just east of Blissfield.
- I-94, Jackson County, has two lanes maintained in each direction between Sargent Road and the Jackson/Washtenaw county line with a traffic shift. All traffic is shifted to the eastbound side of the roadway.
- I-94 Business Loop (Michigan Avenue), in Jackson, has one lane open in each direction with a traffic shift between Lawrence Avenue and M-60.
- M-60, Jackson County, has one lane open in each direction on the bridge over I-94 BL (Michigan Avenue). On I-94 BL under the bridge there is one lane open in each direction.
- Page Avenue near Jackson, Jackson County, has one lane maintained in each direction over US-127. Two lanes of US-127 will be open in each direction with a shoulder closure under the bridge.
- I-94, Kalamazoo County, has two lanes open in each direction over Westnedge Avenue in Portage with a traffic shift.
- I-94, Calhoun County, will have two lanes open in each direction near Albion.
- I-96, Ingham County, will have one lane open in each direction between US-127 and Meridian Road.
- M-43 (Grand River Avenue), Ingham County, is currently closed just west of M-52 near Williamston. A detour is posted.
- Grand Ledge Rest Area off eastbound I-96, Clinton County, is closed.

- Kip Road, Ingham County, is closed over US-127 with traffic detoured. Two lanes of traffic on US-127 open in each direction with a shoulder closure.
- M-100 (Wright Road), Clinton County, near Grand Ledge, is closed at I-96 with traffic detoured. Two lanes of traffic are maintained in each direction on I-96 with a shoulder closure.
- I-69, Shiawassee County, will have one lane open in each direction between M-52 and M-13.
- M-71, Shiawassee County, is closed over I-69 with a detour posted.
- US-24 (Telegraph Road) under I-275, Monroe County, has one lane open in each direction. In addition, the ramp from northbound US-24 to northbound I-275 is closed with a detour posted. And the ramp from southbound US-24 to southbound I-275 is closed with a detour posted.
