Subject: FY 2012-2014 Small Urban Program Call for Projects

Your community is eligible for Federal Surface Transportation Program funds that have been earmarked for areas of 5,000 to 50,000 populations (Small Urban Program). The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will be accepting Small Urban Program project applications for FY 2012-2014. In order to be eligible for funding, proposed projects must be within the federal-aid urban area boundary and must be located on the federal-aid highway system.

Projects are awarded to small urban areas on a rotating basis. The maximum federal amount awarded for a project is \$375,000 in federal dollars, which the implementing area must provide a 20 percent local match.

The federal transportation bill, the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, and Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users, expired on September 30, 2009. Although as of this date a new federal transportation bill has not been authorized, we are hopeful it will pass in time to successfully implement a FY 2012-2014 Small Urban Program. Our hope is that the funding levels will increase, but there is no guarantee until federal legislation is authorized. While we at MDOT feel it is important to continue the planning process, we would be remiss in not reminding you of the precariousness of future funding. Therefore, keep this in mind as you plan your future construction program.
