

# I-75/I-675 Detour Routes

## Deer Season 2013

It's firearm deer season and motorists can expect delays due to ongoing construction on northbound I-75 and I-675 through Saginaw County. Choosing an alternate route may require driving additional miles, but could save you time overall by avoiding expected delays on I-75. Motorists heading up north during the 2013 hunting season (through late November) from the Metro Detroit and Flint areas should consider taking one of the following routes:

- To areas north of Grayling: Take westbound I-69 to northbound US-127, then northbound I-75. Additional distance traveled: approximately 50 miles.
- To areas south of Grayling: Take eastbound I-69 to northbound M-15, then westbound M-25 to northbound I-75. Additional distance traveled: approximately 10 miles.
