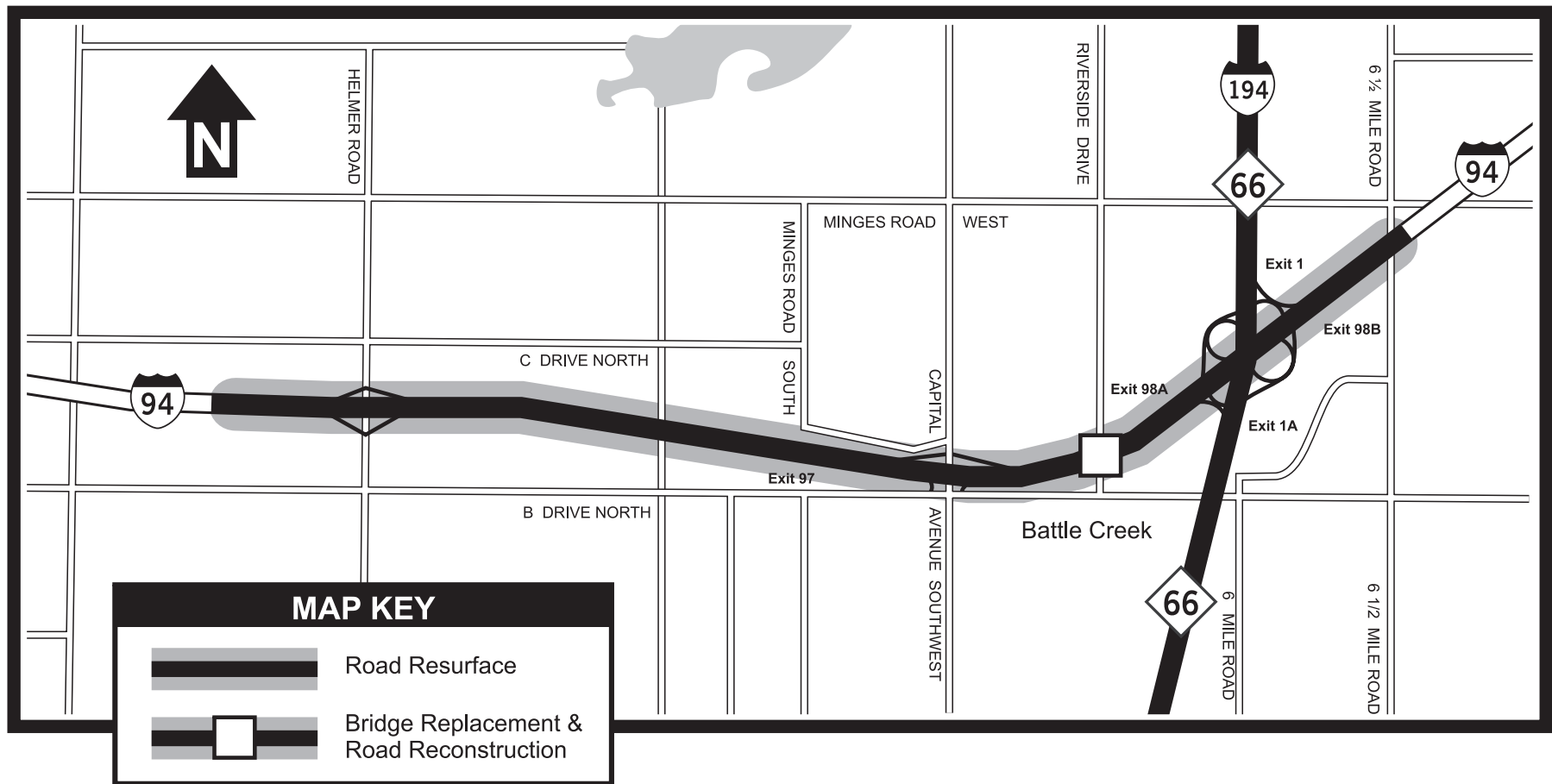

What Is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) is investing approximately \$10 million to resurface 4.5 miles of eastbound and westbound I-94 between Helmer Road and 6 ½ Mile Road, replace the I-94 bridges over Riverside Drive, and reconstruct Riverside Drive under I-94 in Battle Creek. This project also includes guardrail upgrades, ramp resurfacing, and new sidewalk construction on Riverside Drive.

When Will This Be Done?

Work will begin April 13, 2009 and will be completed by Nov. 13, 2009.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

From April to September, one lane of I-94 will be maintained in each direction at night, and both lanes will be maintained from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. on weekdays. Ramp traffic will be maintained at all times.

Two lanes of traffic will be maintained during the construction of the Riverside Drive bridge, and Riverside Drive traffic will be detoured along Beckley Road, Capital Avenue Southwest and East Minges Road from April to November.

To ensure limited inconveniences for motorists, the contractor will be fined if traffic is not fully open on-time every morning on I-94.

Long-term Benefits

These improvements will serve motorists for many years to come.

MDOT's 2009 reduced highway program strategy focuses on preservation and keeping motorists mobile, informed and safe.
