

# I-96/Latson Road interchange

Livingston County

Fall 2012 – November 2013

## What Is Being Done?

This fall, the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will begin construction of a new interchange at I-96 and Latson Road near Howell in Livingston County. The project will take two years to complete.

Construction this fall involves relocating Beck Road, clearing and removing trees, relocating utilities, and permanently closing the westbound I-96 rest area in order to make room for the new westbound off ramp.

The majority of construction of the new interchange is expected to begin in spring 2013, with final project completion expected in November 2013.

## The overall project involves:

- Constructing a new bridge extending Latson/Nixon Road over I-96,
- Building new ramps to connect I-96 and Latson/Nixon Road,
- Reconstructing and relocating Grand Oaks Drive and Beck Road,
- Reconstructing and widening Latson/Nixon Road,
- Resurfacing and widening the Grand River Avenue/Latson Road intersection,
- Removing the existing rest area along westbound I-96, west of Lake Chemung, and
- Work on an enhancement project to add a nonmotorized path along the west side of Latson/Nixon Road from Grand River Avenue to Beck Road.
