

What Is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will be rebuilding the M-222 bridge over US-131 in Martin, Allegan County.

When Will This Be Done?

Work begins in February. The new M-222 bridge will be open to traffic the first week of June, with the entire project expected to be completed by July 2.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

M-222 will be closed over US-131 during reconstruction. US-131 will have lane closures under M-222 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m, as well as night-time single-lane closures. Throughout construction, all ramps will remain open.

Long-term Benefits

This project will increase safety and extend the service life of this bridge.
