What Is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) is investing approximately \$1.35 million to rehabilitate the M-222 bridge, and \$500,000 to rehabilitate the M-89 bridge, both over the Kalamazoo River in the city of Allegan. These projects include structural steel repairs, painting, and deck work.

When Will This Be Done?

Work will begin in April and will be completed by August.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

M-222 traffic will be reduced to one lane in alternating directions using a temporary traffic signal. River Street will be detoured throughout the project on Airway Drive, Industrial Drive, and 118th Avenue.

One lane will be open in each direction on M-89 using traffic shifts. Access to area businesses and residences will be maintained throughout the project.

Long-term Benefits

This project will extend the life of the bridges and provide a smoother ride for motorists.

MDOT's 2009 reduced highway program strategy focuses on preservation and keeping motorists mobile, informed and safe.
