What Is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will be repairing bridge deck joints and replacing pier caps on the M-40 bridge over the Rabbit River in the city of Hamilton.

When Will This Be Done?

Work is scheduled to start in mid-June and be completed by the end of August.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

One lane of alternating traffic will be maintained over the bridge via temporary traffic signals between Washington Street and 150 feet north of the bridge.

Long-term Benefits

This project will extend the life of the bridge and provide a smoother ride for motorists.

MDOT's 2009 reduced highway program strategy focuses on preservation and keeping motorists mobile, informed and safe.
