## What Is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will oversee the reconstruction of M-52 between Morrice Road and M-21 in Owosso. Work involves roadway reconstruction, new curb and gutter, storm sewer and water main improvements, railroad crossing reconstruction, traffic signal upgrades, and sidewalk improvements.

Once the project is complete, M-52 will be restriped from its current four-lane configuration to a three-lane roadway with a center-turn lane.

## How Will Traffic Be Affected?

Construction will be done in stages to minimize the inconvenience on motorists and residents.

### Stage 1 - NB and SB Detour

The first stage, between Fletcher Street and M-21, is expected to begin in early April. Work will start first on the two railroad crossings, which will be reconstructed one crossing at a time. A full closure of M-52 is required for this work.

During construction, local access to all businesses and residents will be maintained.

### Stage 2 - SB Detour

During this stage, one lane of northbound traffic will be maintained on M-52 at all times, with all southbound traffic detoured using M-21 and Delaney Road.

Work on the entire project is expected to wrap up in November.
