


### Q3 In what capacity are you assessing our performance in managing road construction? (Please select all that apply)



### Q4 What area(s) of state roads will you be evaluating? (Please select all that apply)



**Q5 Were you delayed in a construction zone on a state road this past week? If so, which of the following choices best describes your experience?**






