


Q3 In what capacity are you assessing our performance in managing road construction? (Please select all that apply)



Q4 What area(s) of state roads will you be evaluating? (Please select all that apply)



Q5 Were you delayed in a construction zone on a state road this past week? If so, which of the following choices best describes your experience?



Q6 What time of day did you experience delays in MDOT construction zones?





1	<p>1) "Newburgh to Telegraph Closed" on the sign boards is useless information. Locals would know they are closed by now, and those outside the area wouldn't know "Newburgh" or "Telegraph". They would know them as "I-275 to US24". 2) The eastbound concrete patches on I-96 from Kent Lake to Novi are dangerously tall. I hope you grind them down before the plows come through. The plows are going to be torn apart by these patches. They are so tall that they are acting as speedbumps; people are slowing down before they hit them. 3) Did you really think through the extra traffic that would be on I-96 from Kent Lake to Novi due to the I-96 I-275 to us24 closure?
