

Professional Engineering/Professional Surveying Prequalification Requirement Change

In October 2008, the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) sent letters to consultants reminding them that MDOT was requiring documentation in support of all the new professional registration requirements, as identified in the MDOT Consultant Prequalification Application Instructions, for each of the following nine prequalification classifications:

- Road Construction Engineering
- Bridge Construction Engineering
- Capital Preventative Maintenance
- Project Development Studies
- Right-of-Way Surveys
- Road Design Surveys
- Structure Surveys
- Photogrammetric Surveys
- Hydraulic Surveys

The requested documentation was supposed to be submitted no later than January 31, 2009.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE JANUARY 31, 2009, DEADLINE HAS BEEN TEMPORARILY RESCINDED, AND THE REQUIREMENT TO SUBMIT DOCUMENTATION HAS BEEN POSTPONED UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.

MDOT is currently reviewing the prequalification requirement change, and will provide updates on this subject as they become available.
