

Summary of Responses to Requests for Letters of Interest For Public-Private Partnerships

The MDOT received a total of twelve (12) Bridge Bundling Letters of Interest (LOI's) on August 20, 2013. We are currently reviewing the LOI's and their content. The LOI's indicate the respondents are interested in a larger Design, Build, Finance, Operate and Maintain Contract. The contract amounts varied among the responses, but were typically from \$100 to \$600 Million. The length of contract also varied between the respondents, but typical responses were from 30 to 40 years.

The MDOT received a total of twelve (12) Freeway Lighting Letters of Interest (LOI's) on August 12, 2013. The LOI's indicated sufficient interest in any size project listed in the request (Tunnel Lights, Regional Project, or Statewide).

Most respondents appeared comfortable with a longer term contract, greater than 15 years. However, responses did vary from 5 to 35 years.

The MDOT received a total of five (5) Rest Area Letters of Interest (LOI's) on August 12, 2013. The LOI's varied heavily in their response. The majority of the respondents indicated they were only looking for advertising and sponsorship opportunities and weren't interested in the operation and maintenance activities. Since most of the responses discussed advertising and sponsorships, the length of the contract was not really identified.

The MDOT received a total of two (2) Timber Management Letters of Interest (LOI's) on August 12, 2013. The LOI's indicated interest in the project, but noted a timber survey would be needed to fully assess the proposed areas viability. The contract length varied from an annual contract to a multiple year contract to help maintain forest management activities.
