

As needed inspection and testing services throughout the Metro Region for pavement marking QA1 Requisition #836

1) Does the RFP include an “as needed” office technician?

A) Yes. The RFP mentions under, Description of Work- “The Construction Services are as follows: inspection, quality assurance testing and reporting, measurement, computation documentation of quantities, reporting and record keeping; and assist in close out of project documentation.” Also, one of the Secondary Prequalification Classifications is , “Technical Assistance”.

1) If an office technician is required, where will their work station be located?

A) The Consultant’s office.

2) If an office technician is required, where will the project documentation be stored?

A) In the same location the office technician will be working from. Project documentation will be transferred from MDOT to the Consultant, when needed.

3) What are the construction project numbers that this RFP will be inspecting?

A) 84917-113811A and 84917-113889A

4) When concrete cylinders are made for testing the concrete, who will be responsible to condition the cylinders in a water bath, test the compressive strength and report the results? The Consultant or MDOT?

A) The contract has QA set up. The contractor is responsible for the curing and testing of the cylinders. We are requesting testing for MDOT based on section 605.03.B.3.

5) Are there only two projects that this RFP will be working on?

A) Yes, as of now.
