

**Design Services for ADA Ramps including Surveys-Metro Region**  
**Requisition #1004 QA1**  
**10/2/2012**

Q1. A preliminary review of the project site revealed there are in excess of 250 sidewalk ramps/quadrants included in the project limits. However, a number of the ramps already appeared to meet ADA standards (some having been improved rather recently). Does MDOT have an estimate of how many ramps are anticipated to be included in the projects survey and design? Will all ramps require survey and verification of ADA compliance? Or, will only those ramps that obviously need upgrade or are maybe only marginally ADA compliant needing verification and upgrade need to be surveyed?

**A1. Some ramps have been updated along the corridor. It will be the responsibility of the consultant to check each updated ramp to make sure they are ADA compliant. If they are, then they will not be redesigned as part of this project. All other ramps will need to be designed to meet ADA requirements. If ROW is needed to make a ramp ADA compliant, then the ramp will be updated to get as close to ADA compliance as possible without additional ROW and a justification form will be completed.**

Q2. I would like to confirm the survey required for the project. I reviewed the survey scope of work included in attachment A but there was little project specific information in that section. My question is will topographic and/or ROW surveys be required for the entire project length or only in the intersection areas of ADA ramp work?

**A2. The survey tasks in the RFP are for ADA ramp design only.**
