

**Development of alternatives for the replacement, repair, strengthening, and/or stabilization

**Q:** Our firm typically includes a subconsultant on our team to provide geotechnical engineering services, but noticed that the M-10 Retaining Wall project requires that the prime firm be prequalified in this prequalification classification. There may be numerous other consulting firms that do not hold the geotechnical classification. Is it possible that the geotechnical prequalification could be changed to a secondary prequalification classification for the purposes of this submittal?
