Q: Why are the Complex Bridges and Complex Urban Freeway Design prequalifications required for this project?

- A: The **Complex Bridges** prequalification is required for this project for a number of reasons. These include, but are not limited to:
- MDOT's desire to include innovations in the project, some of which may not have been used in the State of Michigan before.
 - The span lengths required to accommodate the future typical section of I-94 may require the use of beams not currently included in MDOT's standards.

The **Complex Urban Freeway Design** prequalification is required based upon the project being located within a segment of I-94 that includes enclosed drainage, multiple grade separations and interchanges, and is located immediately west of the I-94/M-10 interchange. In addition, the project must be designed to accommodate the future improvements to I-94 that are being proposed as part of the I-94 "Mega Project", including future service roads.
