Question 1: Does a firm who provides mobile LiDAR mapping, need to be prequalified? Does a firm who provides mobile LiDAR mapping need to be prequalified if they will be sub-consulting to the Prime firm and the Prime firm has Prequalification in the primary prequalification categories listed in the RFP?

Answer 1: If the prime does NOT have mobile LiDAR capabilities, then they must subcontract with a firm that possesses this capability and is prequalified in the classification(s) shown in the scope.

The scope was revised to include the Photogrammetry Prequalification as precautionary.

Please note that this category may not be utilized.

Question 2: The RFP mentions that a spreadsheet estimate of hours needs to be provided. Is that required at the proposal stage? Or is that referring to the priced proposal staged after a selection has been made?

Answer 2: A spreadsheet estimate of hours will not be required as part of the initial proposal stage. The hours estimate will be required after a consultant has been selected, at the time of price proposal.

Question 3: The RFP requires that a detailed work plan be provided in the proposal. This will require that we contact traffic and safety to discuss traffic control requirements. Developing this will require a significant amount of effort and we want to confirm that it is in fact required at this stage before beginning that effort.

Answer 3: For the purpose of preparing this proposal, do not contact traffic and safety. A detailed work plan is required and should be put together based on your experience, past projects and the information available in this RFP.

Question 4: There is a 7 page limit for the proposals. If a detailed work plan and spreadsheet estimate of hours is required, do those documents count toward the 7 page limit?

Answer 4: The spreadsheet estimate is not needed at this time and not a part of the 7 pages. The detailed work plan will be counted as part of the 7 pages.
