We have a question related to the RFP, regarding the requirement for a “Technical Proposal”. The guidance on this indicates that if required, the RFP will provide more information on the requirements of the Technical Proposal, but in reviewing we do not see any guidance as to what should be included and how it relates to the standard proposal content required. Questions:

Q 1 Is this being required ONLY if a team is shortlisted for an interview, or are all submitters required to include it in the original submission by the 1/27 deadline?

A 1 **Yes. Additional guidance will be given to those teams that are shortlisted for an interview.**

Q 2 It appears from the MDOT Consultant Vendor Selection Guidelines, section 3.2.6, that this is supposed to be supplemental to the standard proposal (not a stand-alone document), with additional supporting information per the four sections outlined. Is our understanding correct?

A 2 **This is supplemental and further guidance will be given if the consultant team is short-listed.**

Q 3 Additionally, if this must be included by all submitters, could you clarify what information is being requested under the “General Information” section?

A 3 **It is not required at this time. See above.**
