

**Specialty Services for ESS Equipment Installation throughout the Upper
Peninsula Requisition 1000**

Q: Are there prequalification requirements for a prime bidder on RFP 1000? What are the requirements for prime bidders to bid on RFP?

A: There is no Primary or Secondary Prequalification classifications for RFP 1000.

If selected, the vendor must make sure that current financial information, including labor rates, overhead computations, and financial statements, if overhead is not audited, is on file with MDOT's Office of commission Audits. This information must be on file for the prime vendor and all sub vendors so that the contract will not be delayed. Form 5100J is required with Proposal for firms not currently prequalified with MDOT.

Q: Is it possible to delay the Requisition 1000 by one week to accommodate a full and thorough response?

A: Not at this time. Responses are due by 10/15/2012.

Q: In the bid items what is meant by "Supplied" equipment?

A: These items will not be installed. They will be provided to MDOT during the contract.

Q: In the maximum pages, of 14, are resumes included as part of the 14 pages or counted in addition to the 14 maximum?

A: Resumes are not included in the 14 page count.

Q: Is the bid pricing sheet included in the 14 page maximum or counted in addition to the 14 page maximum?

A: The bid sheet is not included in the 14 page count.
