Q: The scope of service in the RFP lists specific Consultant Responsibilities and Deliverables. Does the P.I. need to address all of them, i.e., must all deliverables listed in RFP be promised in the proposal?

A: As proposals are reviewed 40 of the possible 150 points are related to the understanding of service. This category will include the proposed scope of services. The panel of MDOT employees scoring each proposal will be looking to see if the scope of services outlined in the request for proposal (RFP) are addressed. It is recommended that each proposal include as many deliverables as feasible within the RFP's budget and time to increase the likelihood of proposal selection through the competitive process.
