

## Governmental Signing

Placement of permanent non-traffic regulating signs by governmental agencies within State highway Right-of-Way is allowed if such signs do not interfere with the operation and maintenance of the state highway and serve a general public interest.

Applicants must submit an individual permit application package through the Construction Permit System (CPS) with the following, if applicable:

- A resolution from the governmental agency indicating the general public is served by placing the sign and the governmental agency agrees to maintain the sign, if applicant is a local governmental agency.
- Memorandum of Understanding, if applicant is state governmental agency.
- Letter of understanding, if applicant is a Federal governmental agency.
- Necessary approvals from underlying fee owners or other parties of interest.
