



Metro Detroit Weekend Construction Updates
December 4-7

The following construction activities are scheduled for the weekend beginning Friday, December 4, and ending Monday, December 7. As always, some of this work maybe postponed due to inclement weather.

I-96:

In Detroit, eastbound and westbound I-96 will be closed between Schaefer Road and Livernois Avenue for bridge demolition. The full closure will begin at 9 p.m. on Friday and be removed by 5 a.m. on Monday. During the full closure, all eastbound and westbound traffic will be directed to Grand River Avenue. Crews will be demolishing the Elmhurst Road and Oakman Boulevard overpasses.

M-10 (Lodge Freeway):

At the Detroit/Southfield border, northbound and southbound Lodge will be closed under 8 Mile Road for ongoing bridge work. The full closure begins at 6 a.m. on Saturday and will end by 5 a.m. on Monday. During the full closure, traffic will be routed up the 8 Mile exit ramp and down the 8 Mile entrance ramp for each direction.

I-696:

In Oakland County, bridge work will result in the closure of the two left lanes of westbound I-696 from M-1 (Woodward Avenue) to Evergreen Road. The double lane closure begins at 5 a.m. on Saturday and will end by 5 p.m. on Sunday.

In Oakland County, bridge work will result in the closure of the two left lanes of eastbound I-696 from Franklin to Greenfield roads beginning at 5 a.m. and ending at 7 p.m. on Sunday.

I-275:

In Wayne County, bridge repair will reduce northbound I-275 to a single lane at US-12 (Michigan Avenue) beginning at 6 a.m. on Saturday and ending by 5 a.m. on Monday. In conjunction, the ramp from eastbound Michigan Avenue to northbound I-275 will be closed during the same time frame.

I-94/M-39 (Southfield Freeway):

In Wayne County, the following lane restrictions are needed for detailed bridge inspections at the I-94/M-39 interchange in Allen Park. The work is weather dependent.

- Friday, December 4, the left lane will be closed on the existing two lane ramp from northbound M-39 to westbound I-94 from 9 a.m.-3 p.m.
- Saturday, December 5, the left lane of northbound M-39 will be closed at I-94 from 9 a.m.-3 p.m.
- Sunday, December 6, the right lane of northbound M-39 will be closed at I-94 from 9 a.m.-3 p.m.
- Monday, December 7, alternating right and left lane closures on the existing two lane ramp from eastbound I-94 to northbound M-39 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

The following permits have been issued for Holiday Parades this weekend:

M-24:

In Oakland County, M-24 will be closed between Broadway and 1st Street in Oxford from 2 p.m. to 3 p.m. on Saturday.

M-150 (Rochester Road):

In Oakland County, M-150 will be closed between Avon and Tienken roads on Sunday from noon until 5 p.m.

M-59:

In Oakland County, eastbound and westbound M-59 will be closed between Saginaw Street and Dwight/Cherokee streets for Pontiac's holiday parade. The closure will be from 10 a.m. until 1 p.m. on Saturday.
