




 NATIONAL TRUCK NETWORK

 SPECIAL DESIGNATED HIGHWAYS

Those state highways identified by the color codes green and gold have been designated for operation of the following combination of vehicles:

WIDTH

102 Inches including load.

LENGTH

Truck tractor, semi-trailer or truck tractor and 2 semi-trailers: no overall length limitation providing the length of each semi-trailer including load does not exceed 28 feet 6 inches or the overall length of the semi-trailer and trailer or 2 semi-trailers are measured from the front of the first towed unit to the rear of the second towed unit while the units are coupled together does not exceed an overall length of 58 feet, including load.

Semi-trailer length 53 feet when operating in a truck tractor and semi-trailer combination: semi-trailers longer than 50 feet are limited to three axles and shall be 7 feet to 41 feet, measured from kingpin coupling to a single axle or to the center of the tandem assembly.

Truck and trailer or semi-trailer limited to an overall combination length of 65 feet including load.

Truck and trailer or semi-trailer: designed and used to transport saw logs, pulpwood, and tree length poles. Overall length not to exceed 70 feet including load.

In compliance with federal requirements, motor vehicles wholly or partially assembled transported by utilizing 1 tow bar or 3 saddle mounts with full mount mechanisms and using the motive power of 1 vehicle: not to exceed a total length of 75 feet.

The total gross weight of any such vehicle or combination of vehicles shall not exceed a ratio of 400 pounds per engine net horsepower delivered at the clutch or its equivalent under conditions specified in the SAE test code.



Truck Driver's Guidebook

Introduction

The U.S. Congress passed the Motor Carrier Safety Act in 1984. The Act directed the Secretary of Transportation to determine the safety fitness of all motor carriers, subject to federal regulations, operating in interstate commerce. In 1990, Michigan adopted these regulations for motor carriers operating in intrastate commerce. As a result of these actions, Michigan businesses which also operate trucks may be subject to all or some of these rules. Additional requirements are also contained in the *Michigan Vehicle Code* and, in some instances, the "Federal Hazardous Materials Regulations."

The rules and regulations governing the operation of trucks establish minimum safety and record keeping requirements that carriers and drivers must meet. These requirements include, but are not limited to, qualification of drivers; proper licensing of vehicles and drivers; insurance; driver drug and alcohol testing programs; accident recording; driver's hours of service; hazardous material handling and training; vehicle maintenance and inspection; and vehicle loading and weight requirements. Failure to meet these minimum requirements subjects both carriers and drivers to civil and criminal penalties.
