Facing a shortfall in state gas tax and vehicle registration revenues used to match available federal funding in 2011, MDOT is submitting two programs for review. MDOT is now proposing a constrained \$600 million per year program, but should \$84 million in state revenues become available to match federal aid, it would expand to a \$1.25 billion per year program.
