Question 3: Will the information and content of the SOQ's to be submitted on March 24<sup>th</sup> remain confidential until the project is awarded to a responsive contractor?

**Yes. All information submitted as part of the Statement of Qualifications (SOQ) will remain confidential.**

Question 4: Section 3.4 of the RFQ asks for Submitter's experience related to completed projects. Is it acceptable to use relevant projects that are currently under construction?

**Yes. Projects that are currently under construction in which the Submitter is participating will be considered for the experience requirement under Section 3.4 of the RFQ.**

Question 5: Is there any addenda listing the changes between the January bid documents and the current draft plans and proposal?

**No. There is not an official addendum detailing the changes. However, the changes include the following:**

- **Inclusion of the *Liquidated Damages For Failure to Meet Maintaining Traffic Requirements* Special Provision.**
- **Modifications to the *Temporary Falsework and Scaffolding* Special Provision.**
- **Modifications to the Design Loading plan note, in particular, note 4. Construction Live Loads and Concurrent Traffic Loading.**
- **Modifications to the Progress Clause and Maintenance of Traffic**
