



US-31 Project Map



Stage 2



Stage 2:
Mid-May (after Tulip Festival) through mid-August

- Southbound US-31 traffic will be crossed over onto northbound US-31.
- Southbound US-31 will be reconstructed/widened.
- Bridge work will be completed on southbound US-31.
- Traffic signals will be completed on southbound US-31.

Southbound US-31 traffic (two lanes) will be crossed over onto the northbound US-31 side between New Holland Street and Ransom Street.

Southbound US-31 work will be completed between Quincy Street and 8th Street.

Traffic through intersections (Quincy, Greenly, Riley, Felch, James, and 8th streets) will be maintained. No left turns will be allowed at intersections.


Motorists will be able to turn right from US-31 on to side streets, or right from side streets onto US-31.

Each intersection will be closed to east-west traffic for four days to allow reconstruction. Detours will be posted.

Southbound US-31 will be reduced to one lane south of James Street.

During a majority of Stage 2, one lane of southbound US-31 will exit onto Lakewood Boulevard while the other lane will continue south.

For 21 calendar days during Stage 2, the southbound US-31 exit ramp to Lakewood Boulevard will be closed; the two lanes of southbound US-31 will merge into one lane and continue south.



Northbound US-31 traffic (two lanes) will be shifted onto the northbound shoulder between 16th Street and 8th Street to make room for maintaining southbound traffic.

Stage 3

Stage 3:
Mid-August through mid-November

- Northbound US-31 traffic will be crossed over onto the southbound US-31 side.
- All of northbound US-31 will be reconstructed/widened.
- Bridge work will be completed on northbound US-31.
- Traffic signals will be completed on northbound US-31.

Southbound US-31 traffic (two lanes) will be shifted onto the outside shoulder between New Holland Street and Ransom Street to make room for maintaining northbound lanes.


Traffic through intersections (Quincy, Greenly, Riley, Felch, James, 8th streets) will be maintained. No left turns will be allowed at intersections.

Motorists will be able to turn right from US-31 on to side streets, or right from side streets on to US-31.

Each intersection will be closed to east-west traffic for four days during reconstruction. Detours will be posted.

Southbound US-31 will be reduced to one lane south of James Street.

One lane of southbound US-31 will exit at Lakewood Boulevard. The other will continue through to the end of the project limits.



Northbound US-31 traffic (two lanes) will be shifted onto the newly reconstructed southbound US-31 between 16th Street and 8th Street.
