

What Is Being Done?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) is seeking public comment regarding plans to resurface US-127 Business Route (BR) and M-46 later in the 2016 construction season. At the request of the City of St. Louis, MDOT will convert US-127 BR (Main Street) from four lanes to three. This change will create one lane in each direction on US-127 BR from just south of State Street to M-46, with a center left-turn lane and bike lanes on both sides of the roadway.

How Will Traffic Be Affected?

During construction, US-127 BR will be open in each direction using lane shifts, flag control, and temporary signals. The roadway will be detoured for two weeks during railroad crossing work.
