What is MiTRIP?

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) will be implementing a new web-based computer application for obtaining oversize/overweight transport permits. The new system is called Michigan Transport Routing and Internet Permitting (MiTRIP). MiTRIP will be replacing Michigan Permitting and Routing System (MIPARS).

MiTRIP Implementation

The release date for MiTRIP is scheduled for February 1, 2011. Please note that this is just an estimated date and other issues could have an impact on the release date. However, we can assure you that this new application will be rigorously tested and will not be implemented unless it passes a strict testing process.

MiTRIP Benefits

Some of the benefits customers will derive by using this new web application are as follows:

- Order **one or more** single trip permit(s) without meeting the previous requirement of 50 permits per year.
- Pay application fees for permit(s) by using a credit/debit card or electronic fund transfer (e-Check, business check) with bank accounts in the United States.
- Order extended transport permits directly via the web.
- Select a trip on an interactive map.
- Access all oversize and/or overweight restrictions.
- Receive issued permits as an attachment via e-mail.

New Requirements

All Transport Permits customers **will be required** to access MiTRIP through the Michigan Business One Stop website.

Single trip and extended permits will need to be submitted through this system. The Transport Permits Unit will no longer be accepting new extended applications and/or renewals via the mail system.

Once MiTRIP is implemented, all permits fees will be required at the time the permit application(s) is submitted. Therefore, we will no longer be billing on account. Additionally, the final invoice received will be for the previous month's permits that were issued prior to the implementation of the new system. For that reason, the final payment of your account will be due at the same time you are required to pay for the new permit applications within MiTRIP.

User Guide

Through MiTRIP, a user guide will be available to help assist Transport Permits customers in using the new application. Please utilize this resource when questions arise.
