Dear Licensed Supplier/Location Owner:

The Bureau of State Lottery, Charitable Gaming Division has imposed a moratorium on all new and existing millionaire party locations and licensed suppliers. With the increased popularity of millionaire party events, the bureau within its authority under the act and rules, has determined that it is not within the best interest of the public welfare to expand the program further. Therefore, a moratorium will be imposed on new millionaire party event locations and licensed suppliers effective January 7, 2011. Applications and millionaire party location forms received in the Charitable Gaming office post marked after January 7, 2011 will not be approved.

As of the date of this letter, this means:

- a) No millionaire party licenses will be issued for events to be conducted at new locations with the exception of a qualified organization proposing to conduct an event at their own location.
- b) If an existing location operates with a licensed supplier or third party that provides the equipment and or services at the existing location, and the location intends to now provide the equipment with the rental of the facility, the location will be considered a new event location and no licenses will be issued for organization's proposing to conduct their event there.
- c) If a licensed supplier leaves a location and wants to change to another location, this will also be considered a new event location and no licenses will be issued for organization's proposing to conduct their event there.
- d) No new supplier license application for those intending to provide millionaire party equipment and services will be approved.

The moratorium is effective January 7, 2011 and will remain in effect until further notice. Please visit our website at [www.michigan.gov/cg](http://www.michigan.gov/cg) for updates to this moratorium.
