ORDER GRANTING RENEWAL SUPPLIER LICENSE

KONAMI GAMING, INC. ("Licensee"), having been previously issued an annual gaming-related supplier license for the one-year time period beginning November 19, 2002, by the Michigan Gaming Control Board ("Board"); and,

The Licensee having, thereafter, timely filed its required annual Supplier License Renewal Report and fee in the manner and form prescribed by the Board, pursuant to and in accordance with the requirements of the Michigan Gaming Control and Revenue Act, as amended (the Act), MCL 432.201 *et seq.*, and the Administrative Rules of the Board, MR 432.1101 *et seq.*; and,

The Board's Licensing & Regulation Division ("staff") having thereupon conducted the required renewal background investigation of the Licensee in order to determine whether the Licensee is eligible, qualified, and suitable to have its gaming-related supplier license renewed under the supplier licensing standards of the Act and administrative rules of the Board; and,

The Executive Director having subsequently prepared and submitted an Executive Director Report to the Board summarizing the staff's renewal background investigation and pertinent findings regarding the Licensee and its Qualifiers; and,

The Executive Director having made recommendation in the Executive Director Report that the Board find the Licensee eligible, qualified, and suitable to continue as a gaming-related supplier under the supplier licensing standards of the Act and the Administrative Rules of the Board; and,

The Board having reviewed and considered the Executive Director Report; and,

The Board having met as a quorum at its April 9, 2013, regular public meeting and voted to enter this Order finding that the Licensee and its Qualifiers continue to be eligible, qualified, and suitable for licensure under the supplier licensing standards and requirements of the Act and Administrative Rules of the Board and, accordingly, granting the Licensee's request for renewal of its annual gaming-related supplier license for a new one-year period.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that KONAMI GAMING, INC., and its qualifiers, as listed below, are hereby determined to be eligible, qualified, and suitable for licensure under the supplier licensing standards and requirements of the Act and Administrative Rules of the Board:

And,


The request of KONAMI GAMING, INC., for renewal of its annual gaming-related supplier license for a new one-year period shall be and is, accordingly, granted pursuant to the Act and Administrative Rules of the Board; and,

That the Executive Director shall be and is hereby directed to issue an annual gaming-related supplier license renewal to KONAMI GAMING, INC., for a new one-year period upon the Licensee's payment of any outstanding fees in accordance with requirements of the Act and Administrative Rules of the Board; and,

The Executive Director shall issue the Licensee a notice of denial 15 days from the date of this Order if the Licensee fails to pay any of the required fees. Upon issuance of the notice of denial, the Executive Director is directed to notify each casino licensee that it may no longer conduct business with the unlicensed supplier in accordance with the requirements of the Act and Administrative Rules of the Board until further notice of the Board.
