

# Hartwick Pines State Park Snowshoe Lacing Workshop

## WORKSHOP DATES:

Saturday & Sunday, 9 a.m.-4 p.m. both days

- Lace your own pair of wooden-framed snowshoes (with tubular nylon lacing)
- Frames, lacings and bindings are provided by Country Ways Snowshoe Company (Minneapolis, MN)
- Choose from two different styles of snowshoes: The Green Mountain Bear Paw (10" X 36") and the Ojibwa (11" wide X 54" long ); The Bear Paw style is recommended for weights under 200 lbs. (If you need to go with a bigger size, contact us and we may be able to order something larger)
- "A" Style Bindings will be provided as well
- This is a **TWO-DAY** workshop. The past several workshops have shown that we will most likely finish an entire snowshoe the first day and begin working on the second. It is possible that you will not need the entire two days to finish your snowshoes. If this proves not to be the case, you will gain the skills to finish them at home. Most likely, the only thing left for you to do will be to varnish them.
- Fee for this workshop is **\$175/person** (2 frames, lacing and bindings). Reservations are **REQUIRED** and there is a \$25 non-refundable reservation fee. The remaining \$150 is due at the start of the class.
- Class space is limited to 10 participants.
- We will break for lunch so feel free to bring food to eat or you may travel to Grayling to buy lunch. We have a refrigerator and a microwave that you are welcome to use. Bottled water and some hot beverages will be available.
