

## **Transcript for Michigan Prepare Website Radio Commercial**

(Sound of a thunderstorm and power turning off)

Child 1: What's going on? There's no lights.

Child 2: Mom!

Announcer: How prepared is your family for an emergency? What if the power went out for days and you couldn't leave the house? What about your pets?

(Sound of thunderstorm continues)

Child 2: Where's Scooter? He can't stay out there!

Child 1: He's gotta come inside.

Announcer: We may like to think that emergencies are few and far between here. That Michigan is an unlikely target for an earthquake, flood, or terrorist attack.

Child 1: I'm scared.

Child 2: Mom, I'm hungry.

Child 1: Me too.

Announcer: The fact is, anything can happen so we need to plan for anything and practice what to do.

Child 1: When will the lights come on?
