

Children of Veterans Tuition Grant

Fact Sheet for Academic Year 2023-24

Description

The Children of Veterans Tuition Grant (CVTG) provides undergraduate tuition assistance to the children of qualified disabled, deceased, or missing in action (MIA) Michigan veterans.

Application

Students must complete an initial application. To complete an initial application or check the status, the student can log into the MiSSG Student Portal at <u>michigan.gov/missg</u>. For renewal, students must complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

Eligibility

To be eligible for an award, a student must:

- Have completed the initial CVTG application (one time only).
 - Application deadline: July 15, 2024
- File a current-year Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) (required annually).
- Be between ages 16 and 26.
- Be the natural or adopted child of a qualifying Michigan veteran.
 - Stepchildren or grandchildren of the veteran are not eligible.
- Not have been convicted of a felony involving an assault, physical injury, or death.
- Be enrolled in at least six credit hours at a participating institution.
 - All participating institutions are listed on the last page of this Fact Sheet.
- Possess a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent.
- Be a Michigan resident for one year prior to program application.
 - If a dependent student, parent must also be a Michigan resident.
- Be a U.S. citizen, permanent resident, or approved refugee.
- Be an undergraduate student.
- Not be in default on a Federal student loan.
- Have a cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 2.25.
- Meet institution's Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) policy.

Qualifying Michigan Veteran Requirements

The veteran must have been a legal resident of Michigan immediately before entering military service and did not later reside outside of Michigan for more than two years; or the veteran must have established legal residency in Michigan after entering military service.

- Must have died or become totally and permanently disabled as a result of a service-connected illness or injury as determined by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs; or,
- Must have been killed in action or died from another cause while serving in a war or war condition in which the United States of America was or is participating; or,
- Must have been totally and permanently disabled as a result of a service-connected illness or injury prior to death and has now died; or,
- Must be listed as MIA in a foreign country as determined by the U.S. government.

Program Limits

- Awards are for an academic year with the amount determined by the student's enrollment status.
- Full-time students can receive up to a maximum of \$2,800.
- Three-quarter time students can receive up to a maximum of \$2,100.
- Half-time students can receive up to a maximum of \$1,400.

Students may receive scholarship assistance for up to four academic years and a total of up to \$11,200, whichever occurs first. Current and future awards are subject to available and approved funding.
