

Using Classification of Instructional Programs (CIP) Code Cross Reference Index

How can I find which colleges offer a certain program?

Step 1

Find the two-digit CIP Code for the program of interest by referring to **CIP Categories** (http://www.michigan.gov/documents/CIP_Categories_151809_7.pdf).

CIP CATEGORIES
