


The default ratio is very important. Federal law provides that reinsurance payments to a guaranty agency are restricted if, for a fiscal year, the guaranty agency's defaults, as a percentage of loans in repayment at the beginning of the fiscal year, exceeds five percent. Reinsurance payments by the U.S. Department of Education are 97 percent of the amount expended by the guaranty agency if the default ratio is less than five percent. If the ratio exceeds five percent, but is less than nine percent, reinsurance payments are reduced to 85 percent of the amount expended by the guaranty agency and the remaining 15 percent must be paid by the guaranty agency. If the ratio exceeds nine percent, reinsurance payments are reduced to 75 percent and the remaining 25 percent must be paid by the guaranty agency.

\*The annual default ratio (trigger rate) formula changed in FY 2006 per the U.S. Department of Education. The new formula is defaults paid minus applied refunds minus applied rehabilitations divided by loans in repayment. Prior to FY 2006, the annual default ratio formula was defaults by delinquency divided by loans in repayment.

Amount in Millions



Amount in Millions


