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**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO PROVIDE RECOMMENDATIONS
FOR NOMINEES TO UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEMS TASK FORCE**

Act 436 of 2016, which is known as the “Unmanned Aircraft Systems Act,” created an Unmanned Aircraft Systems Task Force. This task force was created to develop statewide recommendations on the operation, use, and regulation of unmanned aircraft systems in the state of Michigan. The task force is comprised of 27 members, all appointed by the Governor.

The Chairman of the Public Service Commission nominates two members to the task force. The nominated individuals must be knowledgeable about the operation of public utilities. One member represents public utilities in the Lower Peninsula, and one member represents public utilities in the Upper Peninsula. Both members representing public utilities have resigned, and, as a result, there are two vacancies for terms ending July 31, 2021. The members of the task force receive no compensation for serving as members of the task force.

The purpose of this notice is to provide interested persons with an opportunity to provide recommendations for potential nominees to the task force. Recommendations must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. (ET), October 25, 2019. Written recommendations should be sent to: Executive Secretary, Michigan Public Service Commission, P.O. Box 30221, Lansing, MI 48909. Electronic recommendations may be emailed to mpscdockets@michigan.gov. Recommendations must include the name, address, contact information, and qualifications of the

potential nominee. Qualifications may be provided in a resume or in other format but should address how the nominee meets the statutory requirements for the position. MCL 259.331(2)(x) and (y). A cover letter is optional. Self-nominations are permitted. All information submitted will become public information.

After review, the Chairman will transmit her nominations to the Governor, pursuant to MCL 259.331.
