Anticipated Reach: 12,000 Households

The Heat and Warmth Fund's (THAW) approach to energy assistance delivery and self-sufficiency services begins with meeting low-income households where they are, connecting on the household's terms, and offering multiple channels through which low-income families may receive assistance and services that will help them move toward self-sufficiency.

Program Details

- Clients screened for eligibility and enrolled through multiple channels: 1) online application; 2) telephone call to THAW's Customer Care Center; 3) mail in application; 4) attendance at a Customer Assistance Day (CAD) event; 5) THAW network agency partners; or 6) Pathways to Potential school sites.
- Case management, varying individualized wraparound services provided through THAW network agency partners.
- Assistance available up to \$1,450 for single utility accounts (gas or electric), and \$2,900 for a combined utility account (gas and electric).
- Client must have made qualifying co-payment in the last six months (electric and gas \$225; combined \$450).
- Eligible clients may receive assistance as many times as needed up to the payment cap.
- Mobile processing events/CADs throughout the State.
- Mobile processing at DHS Pathways to Potential public schools in economically distressed cities; targets 1,500-2,000 low-income households; 1,000 low-income households eligible for energy literacy curriculum.

Additional Services Offered

- Coordination with other human service agencies to link energy assistance with additional services that provide essential needs (food, clothing, shelter); energy education and weatherization; and other longer term wraparound programs and services.
