Potential Study:

- The statewide potential study was cancelled with the loss of LIEEF funding.
- Consumers Energy & DTE may continue with separate potential studies. Overview presentations of their baseline studies will be made in February.

Proposed Calendar/Schedule:

- February: Cadmus will do a short presentation on their baseline study. A link to the baseline study information will be sent via e-mail 2 weeks or more before the next meeting.
- April: Plan to go over the whitepaper outlining EM&V approach. Background documents will be sent out to the group prior to the meeting.
- May: DTE will present on their pilot regarding consumer electronics.

MI Saves:

• Rob was asked by Michigan Saves to get information on convenience/grocery store energy efficiency. Cadmus stated that they would be able to gather information on this subject since they have prior experience with this sector.

Utility Updates:

- The group would like to hear regular updates from utilities. Moving forward 'Utility Updates' will be a reoccurring agenda item.
- For 2011 Consumers Energy believes they were around 130% over their goal for electric and 120% over their goal for gas. They stated they had an issue with getting paperwork from contractors very late in December.
- Contractors struggle with the paperwork because it is due right around their busiest time of the year. Sam Flanery (BSA) stated that they have worked on a standardized form and are having very good luck with it. He volunteered to present about this at an upcoming meeting.

DTE presentation of proposed research methods for M&V work

• The group decided to table the analysis for programmable thermostats to next year in order to analyze both gas and electric savings.
