## **AGENDA**

1. Discussion of proposed Staff Rule 41 (2)

Validate gross energy savings achieved via an impact evaluation. Such impact evaluations shall be comprised of the following components: (a) An audit of energy optimization program savings that ensures accurate counts of installed end uses, proper application of program incentives, and proper transfer of MEMD values; (b) Installation verification which includes verification of actual installation, installations outside of service territories, improper installation and removal of installed equipment; (c) Estimation of net-to-gross ratios for purposes of determining net savings; (d) Measurement and verification of gross savings so as to make adjustments to the MEMD for future program years. Energy savings for program years 2011 and beyond will include all above listed adjustments subject to the following:

- 1. Providers with less than 90,000 customers will not be subject to evaluation steps (b), (c) and (d).
- 2. Providers with 90,000 or more customers, but less than 1,000,000 customers are subject to steps (a) through (c) with step (c) using a deemed net-to-gross value of 0.9.
- 3. Providers with 1,000,000 or more customers are subject to steps (a) through (d) with step (c) using a deemed net-to-gross value of 0.9.
- 2. Discussion of NTG=.9 application for year 2011. Will there be a docket?
- Discussion of M&V work for MEMD calibration
