

## Synopsis of Michigan Renewable Energy Legislation 2009-2010 Pending or Passed Legislation<sup>1</sup>

### Energy Policy

A bill creating and establishing a restricted grant and loan program for renewable energy and energy efficiency. Sponsor: Birkholz.

A bill modifying the definition of renewable energy facility within the renaissance zone act to include fuels and chemicals derived from renewable energy. Sponsor: Brown.

A bill modifying the Natural resources and environmental protection act making it inapplicable to activities under the Great lakes wind development act. Sponsor: Birkholz.

A bill establishing off-shore wind siting rules and requirements to be created by the Michigan Public Service Commission in consultation with other Michigan Departments. Sponsor: Birkholz.
