**ORDER**

On December 7, 2010, Baldwin Commodities Corporation (BCC) filed a complaint against  
Alger Delta Cooperative Electric Association (Alger Delta).

On July 25, 2011, BCC and Alger Delta filed a stipulation agreeing that the complaint should  
be dismissed with prejudice.

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that the complaint filed on December 7, 2010 by Baldwin  
Commodities Corporation against Alger Delta Cooperative Electric Association is dismissed with  
prejudice.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.

Any party desiring to appeal this order must do so in the appropriate court within 30 days after issuance and notice of this order, under MCL 462.26.
