RE: **Questions and Answers to Request for Proposals for an Historic Resource Survey of Modern Resources (1940-1970) In Flint, Michigan And Complete A National Register Of Historic Places Nomination For The Flint Civic Center**

Q1: Do you have an estimated number of resources that will be included in the Reconnaissance Level Survey?

A1: **No, there is not an estimated number of resources that will be included in the Reconnaissance Level Survey**

Q2: Is MSHDA able to provide GIS mapping with attributes to identify construction dates before beginning field survey?

A2: **No, MSHDA is not able to provide GIS mapping with attributes to identify construction dates before beginning field survey**

Q3: Is the time frame of 1940 – 1970 hard-and-fast? We have concern about a Flint building that is Modern in style, but constructed in 1939.

A3: **YES, for the terms of the contract for this project the timeframe is solid. If the consultant discovers an exceptional resource outside the scope of this project, we would appreciate it if they would document the address and provide it to the SHPO. However, no survey form need be completed and no documentation undertaken for a building outside the scope of work.**

Q4: Can you confirm that “CIVIC CENTER” is comprised of City Hall, Police Station, Fire Station and Public Health Building, or is it (as is described in newspaper articles) City Hall, City Hall South, City Hall North, a small domed auditorium, police and fire headquarters?

A4: **At this time the best description we have of the Civic Center campus comes from the October 1958 issue of Michigan Architect & Engineer that includes an article**

on the dedication ceremony of the Flint Civic Center and notes the following resources: City Hall, Municipal Courts Building, Police Facilities Building, Public Health Building, Public Health Auditorium (dome), Veteran's Memorial Plaza with Trilon, and the campus. The fire station would also be included.
