- **Foreclosure Prevention**
Learn about loan modifications and refinance options and what your rights and responsibilities are in the foreclosure process.
- **Financial Management**
Counselors can help with household budgeting, debt reduction, and financial independence.
- **Possible Refinance Options**
Counselors, along with participating MSHDA lenders, can determine if you qualify for refinance programs.
