**SUBJECT:** No Cost-of-Living Adjustment (COLA) Increases in Social Security and Supplemental Security Income for 2010

---

The Social Security Administration has announced there will be **no** Cost-of-Living Adjustments (COLA) in Social Security and Supplemental Security Income **effective January 1, 2010**.

- ◆ Social Security Benefits – No Increase
- ◆ Medicare Premium – The Department of Health and Human Services has not yet announced if there will be any Medicare premium changes for 2010. As soon as that is announced, you will be notified.
- ◆ Federal Supplemental Security Income – No Increase
- ◆ State Supplemental Security Income – For 2010, no change at this time (subject to approval of the final State of Michigan FY 2010 budget so it remains at present rate (usually \$14). Again, you will be notified of any change as soon as information is known.
